

The Ultimate Friday Night Feast

Ordering Takeaway and Delivery

PART 01 Warm-Up Activity

- How often do you order food to your house?
- What is your favorite type of takeaway (sushi, pizza, curry, etc.)?
- Do you prefer to pick up the food yourself or have it delivered? Why?

PART 02 The Scenario

You are staying at a friend's house for a movie night. You are all very hungry and need to decide what to eat. However, you have a limited budget of £40, and one person in the group is a vegetarian. You also need to decide how to get the food, as the movie starts in 45 minutes.

The Menu & Info:

- **City Curry:** (Delivery only - 40 mins). Main dishes: £12. Sides: £4. *Postcode check required.*
- **Noodle Box:** (Pick up only - 15 mins away). Main dishes: £9. Sides: £3.
- **Pizza Palace:** (Delivery - 20 mins / Pick up - 10 mins). Large Pizza: £15. Sides: £5.
- **Taco Town:** (Delivery only - 50 mins). 3 Tacos: £10. Nachos: £6.

THE TASK & GOAL

Decide on a meal plan and complete the ordering process.

1. Discuss the options and choose one restaurant that fits your budget and time.
2. Decide who will pick up the food or who will call to check the delivery address.
3. Roleplay the phone call or the counter interaction to place the order.
4. Roleplay a follow-up call because the food is 15 minutes late.

ROLES & PERSPECTIVES

A: THE ORGANIZER

You want the food to arrive quickly because you are very hungry. You prefer pizza or burgers. You must check if the restaurant delivers to postcode "SW1A 1AA".

B: THE CUSTOMER/CALLER

You are the only one with the food app on your phone. You are a vegetarian, so you must ensure there is a meat-free option. You are worried about the £40 budget.

Procedure

1. **Warmer (5 mins):** Use the questions in Part 1 to get students talking about their personal habits regarding takeaway food.
2. **The Task (20 mins):**
 - Set the scene: The students are friends at a movie night.
 - Group students in pairs or small groups.
 - Monitor as they negotiate which restaurant to choose based on the constraints (budget, vegetarian, time).
 - Ensure they perform the "Ordering" and "Problem" roleplays.
3. **Feedback (10 mins):** Ask groups which restaurant they chose and why. Highlight any good uses of "Shall" or "Will." Correct common errors regarding "to go" vs "takeaway."
